7	WHEREAS: The Coltie app is a great platform for connecting graduate students, undergraduates,		
8	and professors, facilitating mentorship, research collaboration, and academic		
9	networking,

11	WHEREAS: The app is operational, offering features such as profile creation, video uploads, and		
12	soon, profile sharing, bookmarking, user connections, and in-app chatting,		
13	enhancing the academic and professional development of its users,		
14			
15	WHEREAS: With over 350 active users, including a significant proportion of international		
16	students, the app demonstrates a strong potential to support diverse graduate		
17	student needs across all academic disciplines,		
18	WHIEDEAC. Calking aims to assemble the immediate instruction of the single translation of the ICII and durate		
19	WHEREAS: Coltie aims to expand its impact by introducing travel awards for ISU graduate		
20 21	students, promoting academic excellence and research dissemination among its user base,

23	WHEREAS: Coltie has committed a budget of \$5,000 for the travel awards, with Coltie taking		
24	responsibility for selecting award recipients based on the quality of research

33	establishment of the Coltie Travel Award, aimed at fostering academic
