6 7 8	WHEREAS:	Mahsa Amini, a 22-year-old Iranian woman died in the custody of the Morality Police of Iran after being detained for purportedly wearing a hijab "improperly",				
9 10 11 12	WHEREAS:	The protests over the death of Ms. Amini are the largest in Iran since 2019 and have spread throughout the capital of Iran, all of the 31 provinces of Iran, and at least 80 other cities and towns nationwide,				
13 14 15	WHEREAS:	To prevent protests from spreading, the biggest tele-communications operator in Iran largely shut down mobile internet access, the most severe internet restriction in the country since 2019,
