SENATE RESOLUTION F11-SR1 SENATE MEETING October 31, 2011

TITLE: Supporting ISU Research Misconduct Policy

WHEREAS: The issuance of research misconduct policies by federal agencies prompted the need for the Policy Development Task Force to draft an ISU Research Misconduct Policy, and

WHEREAS: The ISU Research Misconduct Policy establishes procedures a recipient of federal funds must follow when research misconduct allegations are raised, and

WHEREAS: The policy sought to address the requirements of federal regulations while utilizing existing procedures. Importantly, the Policy Development Task Force wrote the policy to cover all instances of research misconduct, regardless of whether faculty, staff, or students are involved because research misconduct cases can involve claims against multiple individuals who are not of the same status, be it therefore

RESOLVED: That the Graduate and Professional Student Senate (GPSS) recognizes the importance of the ISU Research Misconduct Policy, and let it be further

RESOLVED: That the GPSS supports ISU Research Misconduct Policy with the intent that it covers all instances of research misconduct, regardless of status, and is adherent to federal research misconduct policies, and let it be further
