SENATE BILL F14-01 SENATE MEETING AUGUST 25, 2014

TITLE:

Ratification of the Constitution

WHEREAS: Iowa State University's Student Activity Center requires that all 14 of its

protected classes be mentioned in Constitutional Non-Discrimination Statement,

and.

WHEREAS: The previous version of the Constitution specified that: "Iowa State University and the GPSS do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, age, ethnicity, religion, national origin, pregnancy, sexual orientation, gender identity, genetic information, sex, marital status, disability,

or status as a U.S. veteran."

WHEREAS: The GPSS is required to specify that disabilities are "physical or mental" and,

WHEREAS: The GPSS Professional Advancement Fund (PAF) committee and its

beneficiaries would prefer retaining the Professional Advancement Grant (PAG)

name, and,

WHEREAS: The Constitution must be ratified by the approval of three-fourths of this Senate,

be it therefore.

ENACTED:

The Constitution be amended and ratified as attached.
