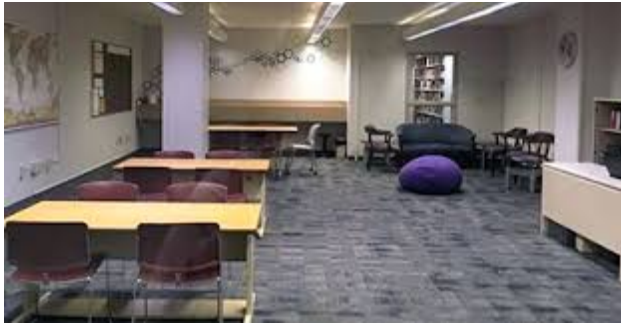
- 1) GPSS Fall Social is being planned

- 1) What is PAG? Professional advancement grant (PAG) is \$200 travel grant money for conferences. It can only be reimbursed after the conference and has to do done within a month of your conference end date. Any graduate students can apply, but only eligible for one PAG per fiscal year (July 1st to June 30th). Application deadline is the 15th of the month before your conference month.
